The successful candidate must have completed a three-year diploma or four-year degree program in theology/pastoral ministry or possess some equivalent combination of education and experience.

Responsibilities

I. Worship & Creative Arts [60-70%]

Cast Vision: Use your leadership influence to achieve our desired goals in worship and creative arts. In a nutshell, Evangel wants to create an environment where there is freedom to worship, listen, and yield to the voice of the Holy Spirit.

Develop the Team: Oversee team members from platform musicians, tech team, and administrative volunteers. Recruit, equip, release, and continue to develop both musicians and tech team volunteers through training sessions and team rehearsals.

Run Events: Lead worship regularly, oversee live streaming and television broadcast of gatherings, provide creative input into special gatherings, host development/training sessions for tech team and musicians.

2. Youth Ministry [20%]

Cast Vision: Use your leadership influence to further the vision and mission of Evangel Assembly within the youth ministry department. In a nutshell, Evangel exists to "reach" and "serve" others within our local content.

Develop the Team: Administrate the youth ministry team by communicating with all volunteers, hosting team enrichment/development nights (i.e., PD nights where kids/youth are not present), ensure that Plan to Protect is always in force, and recruit/train/release new volunteers as needed.

Run Events: Plan, promote and implement a mid-week (Wednesday) youth night as well as other special events and/or trips throughout the year.

3. Flex (Preaching/Teaching/Other Tasks) [10%]

Occasional preaching, staff meetings, board meetings, vision casting, personal growth and development, continuing education, prayer, special interest projects as approved or assigned by the lead pastor, etc.
